OUR AREAS OF FOCUS

WATER & SANITATION

Construction, maintenance, and distribution of WASH infrastructure and supplies, such as wells and drinking water facilities, to ensure safe and reliable access to water and sanitation.

HEALTHCARE

Delivery of mobile health clinics and provision of essential medicines and medical supplies to address immediate and chronic post-disaster health needs, particularly in rural communities.

SHELTER

Provision of non-food items (NFIs), including mosquito nets and solar lamps, alongside the reconstruction and rehabilitation of homes, temporary shelters, and essential community facilities

SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD

Support for communities to restore food and income security through the provision of key livelihood inputs and the promotion of sustainable and locally appropriate practices.

EDUCATION

Restoration of access to education through the provision of learning materials, expanded education programmes, psychosocial support services, and rehabilitation of school infrastructure.

BE INVOLVED

The Mercy Overseas Volunteer Expedition (MOVE) is a **structured overseas corporate volunteer programme** designed to **provide meaningful hands-on engagement** in vulnerable communities across the Asia Pacific.

MOVE enables volunteers to participate in community development projects that support essential needs such as safe water access, shelter reconstruction, sustainable livelihoods, education initiatives, and more.



The MOVE initiative represents a powerful opportunity for your organisation and Mercy Relief to work collaboratively toward creating lasting change in disaster-affected communities.

Employees, students aged above 18, and organisations with a commitment to learning and service are **eligible to participate**.

MOVE is **tailored to volunteers' development needs and skill levels**. We work closely with your organisation and our local partners to **co-create a customised expedition** aligned with community priorities, including the programme itinerary and an indicative budget covering airfare, accommodation, and programme-related fees.

- Adaptive leadership in dynamic environments
- Humanitarian project planning and delivery
- Cross-cultural communication
- Stakeholder coordination in diverse local contexts
